
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PENN FOREST TOWNSHIP  
ORDINANCE NO. 95 - 1, ENTITLED "AN  
ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN FOREST,  
CARBON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING MINIMUM  
REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION,  
ALTERATION, ENLARGEMENT, REPAIR, DEMOLITION,  
REMOVAL, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS  
AND STRUCTURES; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF  
PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES, MAKING OF INSPECTIONS;  
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF;  
KNOWN AS THE BUILDING CODE; AND REPEALING  
INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS OF OTHER ORDINANCES.

Be it ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Penn Forest Township  
that the Building Code be amended as follows:

- (1) In lieu of compliance with the height and area limitations contained in Table 503 of the Building Code, the applicant may submit written approval of the plans for the building by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry. In the event the applicant does not submit such written approval from the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, the applicant must comply with the height and area limitations contained in Table 503 of the Building Code.
- (2) All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- (3) Penn Forest Township Ordinance 95-1 is amended in no other way.
- (4) This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its enactment.

This ordinance is enacted on this 7th day of July, 1997.
