

RESOLUTION NO. 94 - 2

WHEREAS, Penn Forest Township (hereinafter "Penn Forest") is a second class township located in Carbon County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Penn Forest adopted Ordinance No. 94-1, entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF PENN FOREST TOWNSHIP, CARBON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF ACT NO. 537 (P.L. 1535) COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT, AS AMENDED; PROVIDING FOR THE APPROVAL AND INSPECTION OF PROPOSED SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS; PROVIDING FOR THE APPROVAL AND INSPECTION OF PROPOSED WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS; SETTING FEES FOR THE APPLICATION FOR SEWAGE PERMITS AND THE ADMINISTRATION OF SAID ACT AND REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A MUNICIPAL SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 of said Ordinance, the Board of Supervisors shall have the power from time to time to set and amend the fees in the aforementioned Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the fees to be charged under the aforesaid Ordinance are as follows:

1. The fee for an application for a sewage permit under Section 11 of the Ordinance shall be Three Hundred Twenty-five (\$325.00) Dollars.
2. The fee for the Sewage Enforcement Officer to examine a probe hole shall be Forty-five (\$45.00) Dollars.
3. The fee for the Sewage Enforcement Officer to observe a percolation test shall be Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars.

4. The fee for the Sewage Enforcement Officer to review a sewage system design shall be Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars.

5. The Sewage Enforcement Officer shall charge a fee of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars for each on-site inspection.

6. When the examination of the soil profile reveals a limiting zone within twenty (20) inches of the mineral soil surface, resulting in a permit denial, the applicant shall receive a refund of Two Hundred Thirty (\$230.00) Dollars ( $\$325.00 - (\$45.00 + \$50.00$  administrative fee)).

7. If the percolation test fails, resulting in permit denial, the applicant shall receive a refund of One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars ( $\$325.00 - (\$45.00 + \$70.00 + \$50.00$  (administrative fee))).

8. The fee for a permit to install or construct an individual water supply system or community water supply system when not in conjunction with obtaining a sewage permit under Section 14 of the Ordinance shall be One Hundred Twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars.

9. The fee to transfer a permit (including a permit issued under Section 14 of the Ordinance) shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.

10. The fee to renew a permit (including a permit issued under Section 14 of the Ordinance) shall be Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.





11. The fee for "call-backs" shall be Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars.

12. The fee for a temporary or portable toilet under Section 13 of the Ordinance shall be Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month.


13. Any work performed by the Sewage Enforcement Officer for which a fee is not set forth in this fee schedule shall be billed to the person requesting said work at the Sewage Enforcement Officer's hourly rate of Thirty-six and 70/100 (\$36.70) Dollars per hour.
