
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-03 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN FOREST REQUIRING THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS IN THE TOWNSHIP; REQUIRING THE NAMING OF STREETS AND INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS; ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS AND INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; DETERMINING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NUMBERING SYSTEM AND HOUSE NUMBERS; DETERMINING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS AND THE INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" ("Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance").


BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Penn Forest Township, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same, that the following amendment be made to the Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance:


1. Section 10(C)(2) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:
 2. Street name signs shall be at least six (6") inches in height; the letters of the principal street name shall be at least four (4") in height; and, the letters of the street name suffix (e.g. road, drive, lane, circle) or any abbreviations thereof (e.g. RD, DR, LN, CIR) shall be at least one and one-half (1½") inches in height.
2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this amendment to the Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance are hereby repealed.
3. The Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance is amended in no other way.
4. This amendment to the Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after it is enacted.




