

ORDINANCE NO. 88 - 3

Ordinance of the Township of Penn Forest, Carbon County, Pennsylvania, amending that ordinance entitled "Zoning Ordinance for Penn Forest Township, Carbon County, Pennsylvania", enacted .

The Supervisors of the Township of Penn Forest, Carbon County, Pennsylvania, enact and ordain as follows:

Section 1. Amendments

Section 6.201 of the Township of Penn Forest Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as to delete therefrom the following provision and the same is hereby repealed.

6.201 Business and Advertising Signs. One or more business or advertising signs in the commercial and industrial districts are permitted, provided that such signs shall not have a combined gross surface area in square feet exceeding two times the frontage of the lot on which they are located, and in no case shall any single sign exceed two hundred (200) square feet. In no event may any such sign be placed within three hundred (300) feet of another sign.

Said Section 6.201 of said Ordinance is hereby further amended as to add and replace the above deleted portion thereof, with the following:

6.201 Business and Advertising Signs. One or more business or advertising signs in the commercial and industrial districts are permitted, provided that such signs shall not have a combined gross surface area in square feet exceeding two times the frontage of the lot on which they are located, and in no case shall any single sign exceed forty (40) square feet. No one side of any such sign erected shall be less than four (4) feet in length and all signs erected shall be set-back a minimum of ten (10) feet from the right-of-way on which




they front. In no event may any such sign be placed within three hundred (300) feet of another sign.

Section 2. Effective Date.


New Section 6.201 of the Township of Penn Forest Zoning Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of its adoption by the Supervisors of the Township of Penn Forest, Carbon County, Pennsylvania.
