

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-03 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN FOREST REQUIRING THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS IN THE TOWNSHIP; REQUIRING THE NAMING OF STREETS AND INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS; ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS AND INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; DETERMINING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NUMBERING SYSTEM AND HOUSE NUMBERS; DETERMINING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS AND THE INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION."

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Township of Penn Forest duly assembled that Ordinance 2003-03 entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN FOREST REQUIRING THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS IN THE TOWNSHIP; REQUIRING THE NAMING OF STREETS AND INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS; ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS AND INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; DETERMINING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NUMBERING SYSTEM AND HOUSE NUMBERS; DETERMINING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS AND THE INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" be amended as follows:

1. Section 8(A) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

Building numbers shall be depicted in Arabic numerals or alphabetical letters.

2. Section 8(C) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

Each digit or letter shall be a minimum of four (4") inches (102 mm.) high with a minimum stroke width of one-half (1/2") inch (12.7 mm.).

3. In section 9(D), the last sentence shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

Additionally, the owner of each such business shall display the legally assigned number on the rear door to the building in numbers which shall be a minimum of four (4") inches (102 mm.) high with a minimum stroke width of one-half (1/2") inch (12.7 mm.).

4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

5. Ordinance 2003-03 is amended in no other way.

6. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its enactment.
