Penn Forest Township welcomes you to our Transfer Station, invited is Businesses, Residents and Visitors. Currently there is no charge to recycle, just show your permit.

Hours of Operation

Sunday thru Monday 8am-4pm
Wednesday 11am-7pm
(open most holidays)

We ask you to separate and prepare your recyclables before entering the drop-off facility.

Recycling is as easy as

- 1. Rinse recyclable food and beverage containers to keep insects away*
- 2. Set aside a special container for your recyclables at home. Container can be something as simple as a plastic grocery bag, a sturdy cardboard box, crate or bucket*
- 3. Go to the Transfer Station and place your recyclables in the designated containers.*

You may recycle; cardboard, plastic bottles only, aluminum cans, glass food and beverage bottles and jars, magazines, catalogues, office paper, junk mail, glossy inserts and dry newspapers

The Transfer Station will accept; tires, appliances, water heaters,
A fee is charged for disposal of these items.

The Transfer Station will **NOT** accept batteries, plasma or LCD TVs or computer monitors

Benefits of Recycling
