A. <u>PUBLIC COMMENTS:</u> (3 Minute Limit)

PEGGY DUSABLON- STR- what is the process since the deadline will be up on November 8th. Do we call and complain if there isn't a license. Will you start fining if they haven't submitted for a license? Supervisor Bartulovich stated yes it is all automated. We are able to track the properties not in compliance and not registered.

<u>JIM MANNIX - TT- STR</u> -enforcement are you going to do anything physical to come out. Supervisor Bartulovich stated no. Jim Mannix stated so we have to go through TT Security. Supervisor Bartulovich stated I would absolutely say to also call your security. Mannix, can security call? Supervisor Bartulovich stated that yes no reason why not. Mannix, can a second fine be issued for the same incident. Bartulovich stated if it is reported to the 24 hour hotline and not resolved. Mannix, what do you mean not resolved? Bartulovich, if someone calls to put in a complaint, the 24 hour contact person has up to 2 hours to rectify the issue. Mannix, can the phone call be made to the property owner at 3:00 in the morning. Bartulovich stated yes. Bartulovich stated that if the issue is resolved they will call you and state if it was resolved. Mannix stated a second fine can be issued from the township along with the HOAs fine. Mannix, any more movement on the Stoney Mountain Cell Tower. Attorney Nanovic stated the hearing has been postponed and in the process of setting up a new date for the hearing.

ALEX VITTI- IML- STR- My question to the board if I call and complain and I say it hasn't stopped. How do we handle the second calls? Bartulovich stated if you file a false report and it has been determined taken care of then that person filing the false report will be fined. Supervisor Lignore stated always have the security backing you up. Vitti, security will not come to a hearing it is a third party firm. Mannix stated cant the township stated subpoena the security. Attorney Nanovic before magisterial district judge and yes you can subpoena but the magisterial district judge has no ability to enforce the subpoena to hold someone in contempt. Why wouldn't they comply with a subpoena? I would think the association would cooperate with the Township. Supervisor Bartulovich stated I don't doubt we would get cooperation from the association, it much simpler to subpoena a document than and actually person. Attorney Nanovic stated once we start enforcing it we will see how it's going to work in practice. In either case we can subpoena both documents and people.
