

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Penn Forest Township Volunteer Ambulance Association has requested the Supervisors of Penn Forest Township that it be designated as the primary responder for emergency care, first aid and rescue at the scene of emergencies in the Township, as well as the transportation of individuals receiving such care, first aid and rescue to a hospital or other place of medical care; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Penn Forest Township have been advised by the Penn Forest Township Volunteer Ambulance Association that the Association's personnel rendering such emergency care, first aid and rescue, or moving individuals receiving such emergency care, first aid and rescue to a hospital or other place of medical care, are the holders of a current certificate evidencing the successful completion of a course in first aid, advanced life saving or basic life support sponsored by the American National Red Cross or the American Heart Association or an equivalent course of instruction approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health in consultation with a technical committee of the Pennsylvania Emergency Health Services Council; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Penn Forest Township believe it to be in the best interest and welfare of the Township and its residents that an ambulance association be designated the primary responder in order to assist the Carbon County Communications Center

in the prompt and expeditious dispatch of emergency medical services to the scene of an emergency in Penn Forest Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Penn Forest Township Volunteer Ambulance Association be designated the primary responder for emergency care, first aid and rescue at the scene of emergencies within Penn Forest Township, and for the transportation of individuals receiving such care, first aid and rescue to a hospital or other place of medical care.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that unless the services of another ambulance association is specifically requested, the Supervisors of Penn Forest Township hereby recommend to the Carbon County Communications Center that the Penn Forest Township Volunteer Ambulance Association be called in the first instance to render emergency care, first aid and rescue at the scene of emergencies within Penn Forest Township and for the transportation of individuals receiving such care, first aid, and rescue to a hospital or other place of medical care.
